101. LITTERING ON TOWNSHIP PROPERTY.

A. General Provisions. From and after the date of this Ordinance, no person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation shall throw, cast, discard or otherwise cast upon any street, road, lane, walk, public or private lands in this Township, any waste, paper, garbage, cans, boxes, bottles, ashes, metal, glass, wire, cigar or cigarette butts, nor interfere in any manner with receptacles in which such items have been placed or stored prior to the collection of same.

B. Violation and Penalties. Any person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of Subsection A hereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$50.00 nor less than \$25.00 to be paid to the Township Treasurer for and on behalf of this Township. Costs assessed shall be paid separately to the Justice levying such fine.

C. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

102. ACCUMULATION OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH, AND JUNK. 53 P.S. 65708, 65712

A. General Provisions. It shall be unlawful for any resident of West Mahanoy Township or any other person using the public streets, roads, walks, lanes, and public areas in said Township to permit, allow, cause, or create any accumulation of garbage or rubbish or to place, put or permit the storage or placing of a motor vehicle which is abandoned or junked, as defined in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code (75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3351 et seq.)

B. Abandoned Motor Vehicles. Any motor vehicle which is abandoned in violation of this ordinance or the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code shall be disposed of under the procedures set forth in the Motor Vehicle Code 75 Pa.C.S.A. 3352.

C. Notice of Violation. It shall be the duty of any person creating such a nuisance or responsible for the creation of such nuisance to remove such nuisance upon notice of the Township to do so.

D. Penalty. Any person who being notified of his violation of this Ordinance and who does not correct the violation by removal of such garbage, rubbish, or vehicle, within three days after such notice, shall be subject to a fine or penalty of \$10.00 for each such offense to be recovered by summary proceedings against the owner of the land, the person permitting the accumulation of garbage or owning such vehicle.

E. Reimburse Costs of Clean-Up. Any person failing to clean up such rubbish or remove such vehicle within three days after notice shall be required by summary proceedings to reimburse to said Board of Township Supervisors, such sum of money, not in excess of \$25.00 as the Township may expect in the correction of the offense complained of by cleaning, hauling or removing the same.
