**MINUTES**

Meeting of the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Martin.

**ROLL CALL:** Joe Monahan (via telephone), Paul Martin, Michael Kayes, Atty. James Amato, Chief Marvin Livergood, Michael Michalik, and Donald Zimmerman.

**PUBLIC:** none

Minutes of October 18, 2022, public meeting were approved by Monahan, seconded by Kayes, with all three voting yes.

**TREASURER REPORT:** Michalik read off the report (copy attached)

**FIRE REPORT:** Kayes reported that the William Penn F.C. handed in a report for the months of August & September.

**POLICE REPORT:** Livergood read off the report for the month of October 2022. He reported that there were 107 calls that were handled by the police department for the month. Police stated that there were no traffic citations, 6 parking / QOL tickets and zero non-traffic citations. There were two criminal arrests made during the month and Police collected \$700.44 for the month for parking tickets, citations, and accident reports. The year-to-date collection for fines and reports is \$10029.44.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT:** Livergood read off a brief report.

A motion was made by Kayes to approve all the reports, seconded by Monahan, with all three voting yes.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Martin announced that the Township received a letter from Theresa Conti appealing the decision of her husband's handicapped application. Motion was made by Supervisors to approve the handicapped parking space by Kayes, seconded by Monahan, with all three voting yes.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Township received a bid from Brianne McGinn for the property located on Girard Avenue, Parcel # 36-02-0016.009, in the amount of \$1000.00. Motion to accept the bid was made by Kayes, seconded by Monahan, with all three voting yes.

Martin announced that the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors and WMT Police Department agreed to a three-year collective bargaining agreement. Motion to approve bargaining agreement was made by Kayes, seconded by Monahan, with all three voting yes.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Martin announced that the tentative Budget for 2023 has been prepared and there will be no tax increase for the residents. Mileage will remain at 7.15 mils. The Budget is a balance budget with both Revenue and Expenditures at \$1,978,300. Resolution #2022-8 and #2022-9 are included within the Budget. Motion to approve Tentative Budget for 2023 was made by Kayes, seconded Monahan, with all three voting yes.

Martin asked for a motion to approve Resolution #2022-10, resolution amending the Local Tax Collection Law. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Monahan, with all three voting yes.

Martin asked for motion to approve the purchase of a 2023 GMC Sierra 3500HD, 4WD Crew Cab with a 8-foot Reading Utility Box at a cost of \$ 66,232.47 through the American Recovery Program funds. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Monahan, with all three voting yes.

Motion to go to executive session concerning a personnel matter at 7:15 p.m. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Martin, with all three voting yes. Returned from Executive session at 7:26 p.m. Motion was made by Monahan, seconded by Kayes, with all three voting yes.

**PUBLIC:** Martin addressed a code enforcement issue that was brought up by resident, Joe Beacher, Shenandoah Heights. It was stated about people doing major home improvement work and not getting permits or finishing the job. Issues need to be addressed.

Meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m. Motion was made by Monahan, seconded by Kayes.
