MINUTES**

Meeting of the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Martin.

**ROLL CALL:** Paul Martin, Mickey Kayes, Anthony Gladski, Atty. James Amato, Chief Marvin Livergood, Michael Michalik, and Jim Heffner.

**PUBLIC:** none

Minutes of the February 20 meetings were approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

**TREASURER REPORT:** Michalik read off the report (copy attached)

**FIRE REPORT:** William Penn fire company handed in a report for the month of February.

**POLICE REPORT:** Livergood read off the report for the month of February 2024. He reported that there were 87 calls that were handled by the police department in the month. Chief stated the department handed out 23 traffic citations, nine parking and QOL tickets, there was one criminal arrest and eleven non-traffic arrests that were made during the month. Police collected \$ 318.87 for the month for parking tickets, citations, and accident reports. The year-to-date collection for fines and reports is \$ 1739.45.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT:** Heffner read a report for the month of February and stated he had a total of 14 complaints received. He handed out two QOL tickets and mailed three letters. Twelve total permits were issued.

**ROAD CREW REPORT:** none

All of the above reports were approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Chair read off letter from the Schuylkill County Conservation District concerning their approval of the I-81 Logistics Project.

Chair read off letter from the Schuylkill County Conservation District concerning their approval for Service Electric Cablevision Frackville Building.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Chair asked for a motion to hire Bernard Leonard as a full-time road worker with full benefits at a rate of \$17.00 per hour according to contract for CDL licensed drivers. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for conditional approval based on the Planning Commission recommendation to approve the preliminary/ final development plan of JMB Limited for the construction of a solar farm on a 11-acre portion of the subject property consisting of 252.9 acres south of the Morea Road, West Mahanoy Township, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, Tax Parcel 36-06-0019.000. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded Gladski, with all three voting yes.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Martin asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2024-5, a resolution requesting a grant from the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources in the amount of \$67,500 for playground improvements at Altamont Park. Motion was made Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2024-6, a resolution to PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to undertake the Altamont Park Rehabilitation Project. Motion was made Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2024-7, a resolution for Mid Penn Bank signature documents. Motion was made Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

**PUBLIC:** Walter Masinick, Weston Place, asked about the status of I-81 Logistic Warehouse. Martin gave him an update and stated that the supervisors would like to continue to work with SEDCO on seeing more development in that area.

Helen Cocoa and Joe Beacher, Shenandoah Heights, voiced their concerns with nuisance properties, inquired about permits, and out-of-date inspection on vehicles parked on Schuylkill Avenue. Livergood and Heffner said they will address their concerns.

Meeting adjourned at 7:22 p.m. Motion was made by Gladski, seconded by Kayes, with all three voting yes.
