**MAY 21, 2024
MINUTES**

Meeting of the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Kayes.

ROLL CALL: Mickey Kayes, Anthony Gladski, Atty. James Amato, Chief Marvin Livergood, Michael Michalik, and Jim Heffner.

PUBLIC: none

Minutes of the April 16 meeting were approved by Gladski, seconded by Kayes. Motion passes.

TREASURER REPORT: Michalik read off the report (copy attached)

FIRE REPORT: Gladski read off report. Shenandoah Heights F.C. submitted a report for the months of March and April.

POLICE REPORT: Livergood read off the report for the month of April 2024. He reported that there were 98 calls that were handled by the police department in the month. Chief stated the department handed out 12 traffic citations, 12 parking and QOL tickets, and there were seven criminal arrests and ten non-traffic arrests that were made during the month. Police collected \$ 4885.39 for the month for parking tickets, citations, and accident reports. The year-to-date collection for fines and reports is \$ 7545.11.

CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT: Heffner read a report for the month of April and stated he had a total of 10 complaints received. He handed out two QoL tickets and mailed two letters. Twelve total permits were issued.

ROAD CREW REPORT: none

All of the above reports were approved by Gladski, seconded by Kayes. Motion passes.

CORRESPONDENCE: none

OLD BUSINESS: Kayes motioned for Michalik to open the sealed bids for the 2024 Stormwater Improvement Project located on Ohio Avenue and Norton Way. Michalik opened bid and the bids read as follows:

M & J Excavation	\$31,800.00
Lehigh Asphalt Paving	\$92,600.00

Motion was made to go into executive session at 7:07 p.m. by Kayes, seconded by Gladski. At 7:13 p.m., Motion to resume meeting was made by Gladski, seconded by Kayes. Kayes then made a motion to accept the bid from M & J Excavation in the amount of \$31,800, seconded by Gladski. Kayes added the project will be paid out of American Recovery Funds. Motion passes.

Kayes then instructed Michalik to read off the bids for the 2024 Road Improvement Project which were opened and reviewed by Michalik at noon today. Bids read as follows:

Motion was made Gladski to accept the lowest responsible bid made by New Enterprise in the total amount of \$93,778.50 which includes the base bid and Alt #1 (Wyoming Ave), seconded by Kayes. Kayes added that the project will be paid out of Liquid Fuels. Motion passes.
