MINUTES**

Meeting of the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Martin.

ROLL CALL: Paul Martin, Mickey Kayes, Anthony Gladski, Atty. James Amato, Michael Michalik, Chief Marvin Livergood, Mark Pronio and Donald Zimmermann.

PUBLIC: none

Minutes of September 17, 2024, meeting was approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

TREASURER REPORT: Michalik read off the report. (copy attached)

FIRE REPORT: Gladski read off report. The Altamont F.C. handed in a report for the month of August.

POLICE REPORT: Livergood read off the report for the month of September. He reported that there were 121 calls that were handled by the police department for the month. Police stated that they issued 12 traffic citations, two criminal arrests, and had six non-traffic arrests during the month. There were also seven parking tickets issued by the department. Police collected \$943.24 for the month from parking tickets, citations, and accident reports. A total of \$12,705.32 was collected year to date.

CODE REPORT: Pronio read off report. He stated that they received a total of 79 calls during the month. The department issued three citations and sent out 76 rental registration requirement letters. Fifteen rental registrations were paid for along with 12 occupancy permits, also \$6750 was received from amusement tax revenue. Martin commended Pronio for a job well done.

ROAD REPORT: Zimmermann read off report. He stated that the crew have finished all milling jobs for the season. Martin added that they encourage residents to purchase yard reflectors and to put them on the edge of their properties to assist the road crew this winter when plowing.

Motion to approve all reports were made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

CORRESPONDENCE: Chair read off letter from Mike Bodnar Environmental concerning Equipment Crossing and site access driveway for Keystone Anthracite Company near SR 54 east

of the village of Lost Creek. Supervisors discussed Kayes made a motion to approve pending the review of our engineer, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

OLD BUSINESS: none

NEW BUSINESS: Chair announced that Safe Trick or Treat night will take place on Wednesday evening, October 31 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Motion to approve / disapprove Handicapped Parking for Mrs. Row on a property located at 262 Indiana Avenue. Motion to approve was made by Kayes pending an approval note from her doctor, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.
