MINUTES**

Meeting of the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Martin.

ROLL CALL: Paul Martin, Mickey Kayes, Anthony Gladski, Atty. James Amato, Michael Michalik, O.I.C. Ted Buriak, Donald Zimmerman, and Mark Pronio.

PUBLIC: none

The minutes of March 18, 2025, were approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

TREASURER REPORT: Michalik read off the report. (copy attached)

FIRE REPORT: Gladski stated that none were received.

POLICE REPORT: Buriak read off the report for the month of March. He reported that there were 59 calls that were handled by the police department for the month. Livergood stated that they issued 0 traffic citations and made four non-traffic arrests during the month. They also issued four parking tickets. Police collected \$ 656.35 for the month from parking tickets, citations, and accident reports. A total of \$ \$1604.55 was collected for fines and parking tickets for the year.

CODE REPORT: Pronio read off report. There was a total of 59 calls to which 46 were handled during the month. Twenty-one rental registration inspections, eight occupancy permits, and six dumpster permits were received for the month. Seven abandoned vehicles were towed.

ROAD REPORT: Zimmerman stated they will be preparing for spring road repairs, and they have to wait until the asphalt plants start making the hot stuff.

Motion to approve all of the reports were made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

CORRESPONDENCE: Letter was received from Attorney Robert Matta, representing Keystone Anthracite Company, regarding a request to abandon West Penn Street in Brownsville due to the demolition of all the properties located there. Supervisor discussed issue and briefly made a motion to approve the motion, then minutes later, rescinded the motion. Both motions were made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes. Motion then was tabled by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes. This will be further discussed.

OLD BUSINESS: Chair asked for a motion to terminate employee #147 retroactive to April 11, 2025. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for a motion to approve the addition of a streetlight located on 105 Morea Road, Frackville. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

NEW BUSINESS: Chair asked for a motion to approve Resolution #2024-2, signature resolution for new banking account for Recreation grant. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for a motion to advertise for a full-time road crew position. Applicants must have their cdl license. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes. C

Chair asked for a motion to hire Marvin Livergood as a part-time police officer at a rate of \$20.50 per hour for a period of 30 days. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

PUBLIC: Joe Beacher, Shenandoah Heights, complained about the amount of time for the response and if they got a returned call from the police department after filing a complaint. He added there are many issues up in the Heights area. Buriak informed him that he patrols the entire township more than once during his shift.

Helene Cocoa, Shenandoah Heights, questioned where the new streetlight will be located? Martin informed her that it is on Morea Road in the Altamont section. She then requested the Township road crew collect the gravel and dirt on Schuylkill Avenue if residents clean it up into piles.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:23 p.m. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.
