MINUTES**

Meeting of the West Mahanoy Township Board of Supervisors was held on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Martin.

ROLL CALL: Paul Martin, Mickey Kayes, Anthony Gladski, Atty. James Amato, Michael Michalik, Chief Matthew Williams, and Donald Zimmerman.

PUBLIC: none

Minutes of April 21, 2026, meeting was approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

TREASURER REPORT: Michalik read off the report. (copy attached)

FIRE REPORT: Gladski read off a report for the month of March for the William Penn Fire Company.

POLICE REPORT: Williams read off the report for the month of April. He reported that there were 76 calls that were handled by the police department for the month. Police stated that they issued 16 traffic citations, had four non-traffic arrests and issued eleven parking tickets during the month. Police collected \$ 1132.30 for the month from parking tickets, citations, and accident reports. A total of \$3608.00 was collected year to date.

CODE REPORT: Martin read off report. He stated that they received a total of 20 calls during the month. The department issued six written warnings and issued four tickets and two citations with the Magistrate. Two vehicles were towed. He stated that six total citations have been issued for illegal dumping and more cameras will be installed.

ROAD REPORT: Zimmerman read off report. He stated the road project is ready for bid and the crew will be busy milling and filling potholes with asphalt once weather conditions improve.

Motion to approve all reports was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

CORRESPONDENCE: none

OLD BUSINESS: Chair asked for a motion to approve wage increase for Mark Melusky to \$22.00 per hour per contract with an additional \$1 per hour for CDL license. Motion to approve was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for a motion to approve or disapprove Ice 287 G Program in accordance with the proposed memorandum agreement. Chief Williams explained the program in detail. Motion to approve was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair announced that the Township is still looking for part-time police help. The rate of pay is \$25.00 per hour.

NEW BUSINESS: Chair asked for a motion to advertise for summer help seasonal employees. Motion was approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

Chair asked for a motion to advertise for the 2026 Road Program. Motion was approved by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.

PUBLIC: Joe Beacher, Schuylkill Ave, complained to the Board about a paper road located behind Dower's garage that some work was completed recently and stated that it was left a mess. Martin told him that he would let the code officer know about it.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m. Motion was made by Kayes, seconded by Gladski, with all three voting yes.
