

**WEST MAHANoy TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE No. 2025-1**

**An Ordinance, amending Ordinance No. 2004-4 of West Mahanoy Township,
County of Schuylkill in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania prohibiting
unnecessary or excessive noise.**

A. Radios, music, speakers, television sets, musical instruments, and similar devices.

The operation, use, or playing of any radio, television, phonograph, drum, musical instrument, sound amplifier, automobile stereo, high-fidelity equipment, or any similar device that produces, reproduces, or amplifies sound is prohibited when:

1. The sound is of such volume, frequency, or duration that it would be found by a reasonable person of ordinary sensibilities to interfere with the peace, comfort, or normal activities of individuals in any residence, business, or public area on adjacent or nearby properties, regardless of the time of day; or
2. The sound originates from a motor vehicle or portable source and, by virtue of its volume, frequency, pattern, or duration, disturbs or impedes the use or enjoyment of nearby properties, dwellings, businesses, or public spaces, regardless of the time of day; or
3. The sound is repetitive, sustained, or unusually loud, and can be reasonably determined to interfere with the normal use, comfort, or enjoyment of property by others in the vicinity, regardless of the time of day.

This ordinance amendment shall become effective and applicable on August 24, 2025. Duly enacted and ordained this 19th of August 2025, by the Board of Supervisors for the Township of West Mahanoy, County of Schuylkill in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled.
